

Short-Term Rehabilitation, Memory & Long-Term Care

Mary Ann Morse Healthcare Center provides a comprehensive short-term rehabilitation program for patients who are recovering from injury, joint replacements, surgery, or other medical conditions. With an interdisciplinary approach to rehabilitative care and follow-up services, we will work with you to reach your highest possible level of functioning and independence.

ADMISSION

Admission is coordinated by hospital staff and the Admissions Coordinator at Mary Ann Morse. We encourage your family to visit the Rehab Center prior to admission. A tour can be arranged by calling 508-433-4404.

PHYSICIAN SERVICES & TREATMENT PLAN

You may choose to have your rehabilitative care overseen by your own private physician or by a physician who currently practices at Mary Ann Morse. Your treatment plan will be updated as needed by the interdisciplinary health care team, the R.N. case manager, and the physician.

REHABILITATIVE NURSING

Rehabilitative nursing professionals work with the doctors and rehab staff to implement and monitor patient care plans. Our nurses are IV-certified and are highly experienced at wound care, pain management and post-surgical care. We have a certified wound-care nurse on staff as well as a Certified Rehabilitation Registered Nurse.

PHYSICAL THERAPY

Upon admission, our team does a comprehensive evaluation and develops your personal physical therapy treatment plan, which might include:

- Practicing use of a wheelchair safely (transferring, positioning, operating the chair)
- Practice-walking on parallel bars
- Walking, improving gait on outdoor practice area of level and uneven surfaces
- Using a harness system that supports patients as they practice that helps restore confidence

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Our Occupational Therapists will help you recover your ability to perform basic activities of daily living, such as eating, grooming and dressing. The therapist can maximize your level of independence through cognitive and visual perception retraining and by strengthening upper extremities.

They will work with you in the simulated apartment in the Rehab Center, where you can prepare to return home. This apartment includes a fully-equipped kitchen area, washer-dryer, and conventional bathroom.

SPEECH THERAPY

A certified speech pathologist evaluates and treats speech, language, and swallowing disorders. You and the therapist will work together to improve expressive and receptive language skills through exercises, augmentative devices, and other techniques. A consulting audiologist is also available.

SOCIAL SERVICES

We have staff who can help you deal with any non-medical issues related to your health conditions.

NUTRITION SERVICES

A professional food service director and a registered dietician oversee the preparation of nutritious meals. You can choose from a menu. We can accommodate special dietary needs.

AMENITIES

Rooms are equipped with a flat screen television, WiFi access, and telephone. There is a computer station available as well. There is a card and game room on the floor and our Activities Specialists schedule events, entertainment and activities regularly throughout the week. We provide areas for you to visit with family and friends.

DISCHARGE PLANNING

Discharge planning begins even before admission and is done in collaboration with the patient and his or her family. A social worker will assist in arranging services necessary for your return home. Before discharge, a therapist may accompany you on a home visit and suggest alterations in your home if necessary.

Our goal is to return patients to their homes functioning at the highest level possible. If, however, additional support following rehabilitation is preferred, assisted living services at Mary Ann Morse at Heritage in Framingham may be an option before returning home. After discharge, a follow-up call is conducted by the social worker to monitor the continued progress and adequacy of home services.
